Executive Summary

1. Introduction

1.1. Background

During the SoE project, four common training programs, one for each selected blue sector will be formulated to tackle the emerging skill shortage of the maritime domain. These educational items will comprise innovative face-to-face (e.g. summer schools, apprentices) and digital (e.g. Virtual Reality videos, digital competitions) training tools. A digital platform (the sharing-pooling e-platform) will be developed for hosting this novel toolkit. The EMREN; a dynamic ground-breaking network of academics, maritime industrial representatives and public Authorities, will focus on improving relationships between education and the sectors of interest. Furthermore, it will develop targeted and highly innovative mentoring/training initiatives (human big data) that will enable professionals and students to acquire new skills and diversify on their existing skills and competencies.

This report is part of the Task 6.2 of the project. Task 6.2 aims to conduct specific dissemination activities to reach out to a broad range of stakeholders, such as industrial stakeholders and public authorities, raise awareness over the project outcomes/tools, and highlight their added value. The dissemination activities in this Task are additional to the ones described in WPs 4 and 5 (e.g., Workshops, Summer Schools, competitions, Become a (Digital) Expert for a Day etc.). All dissemination activities will be continuously monitored and evaluated by the AB throughout the duration of the project. The following is a short description of the dissemination activities that will be implemented throughout the duration of the project:

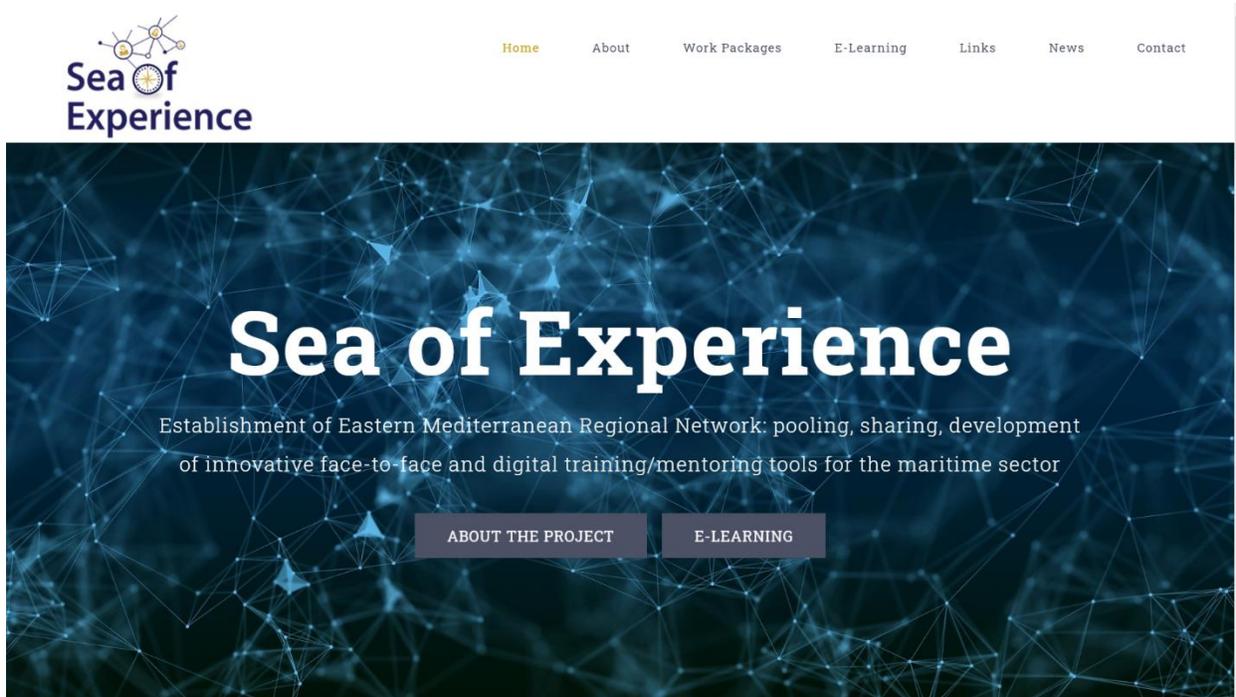


Figure 1 Main page of the website

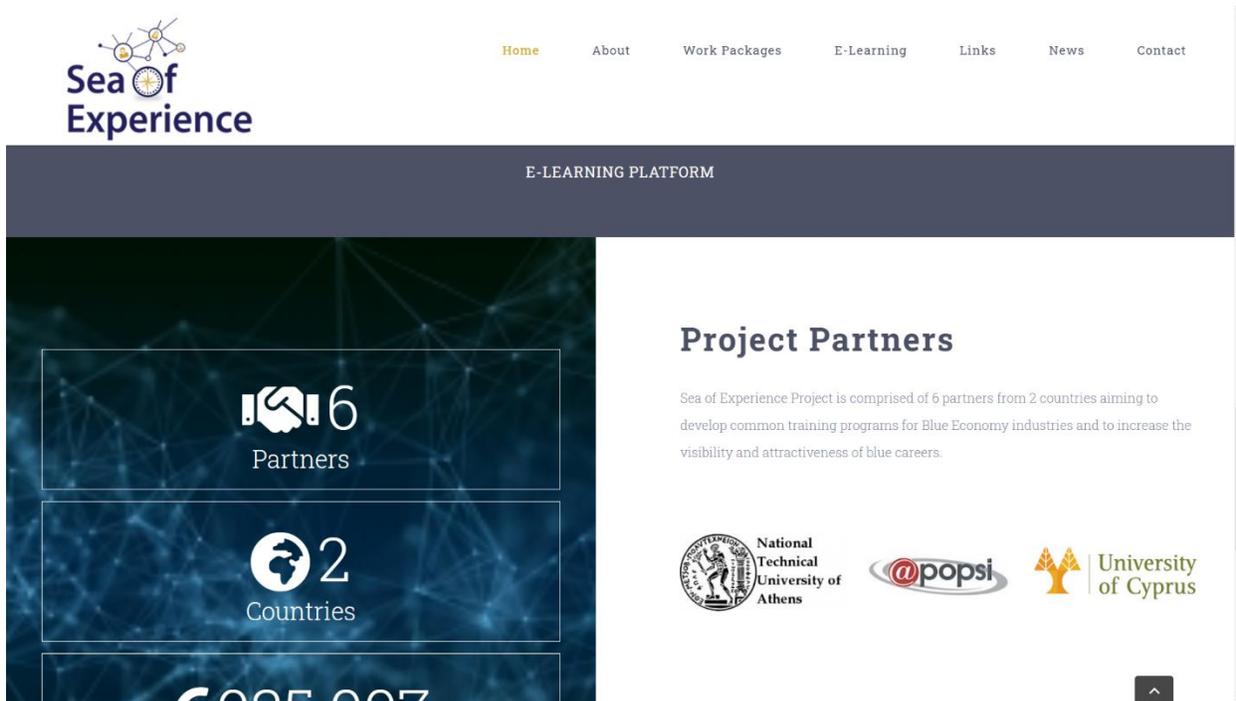


Figure 2 Main page of the website

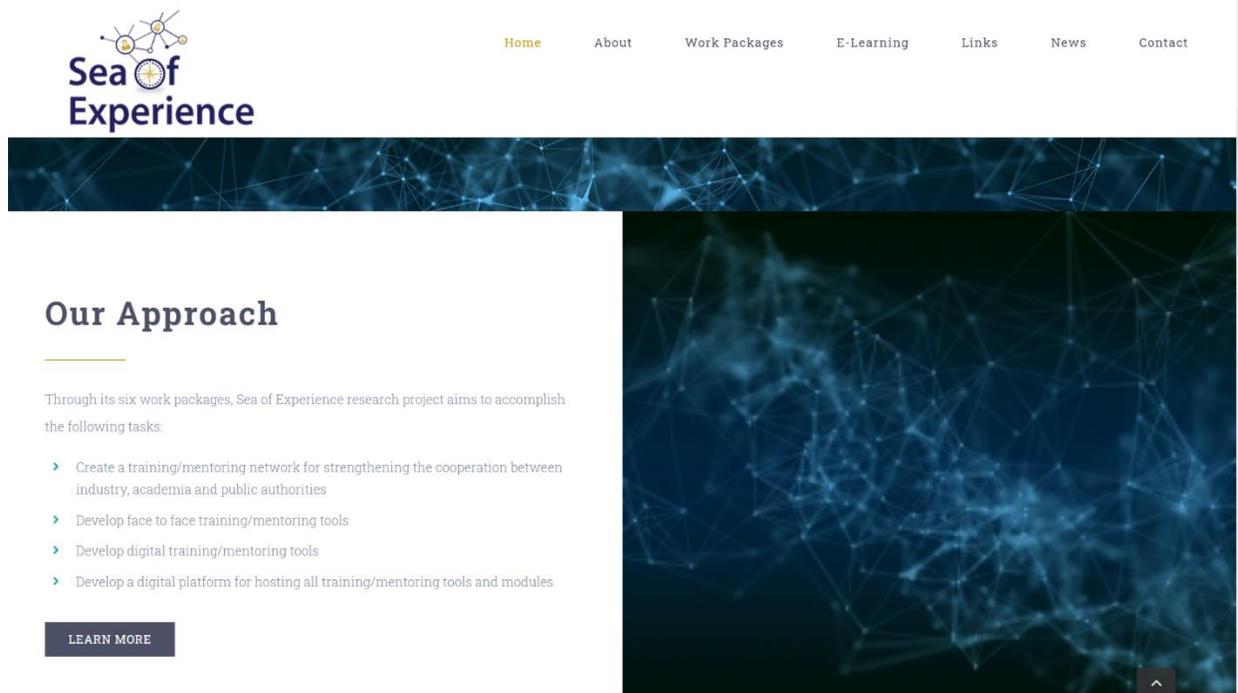


Figure 3 Main page of the website

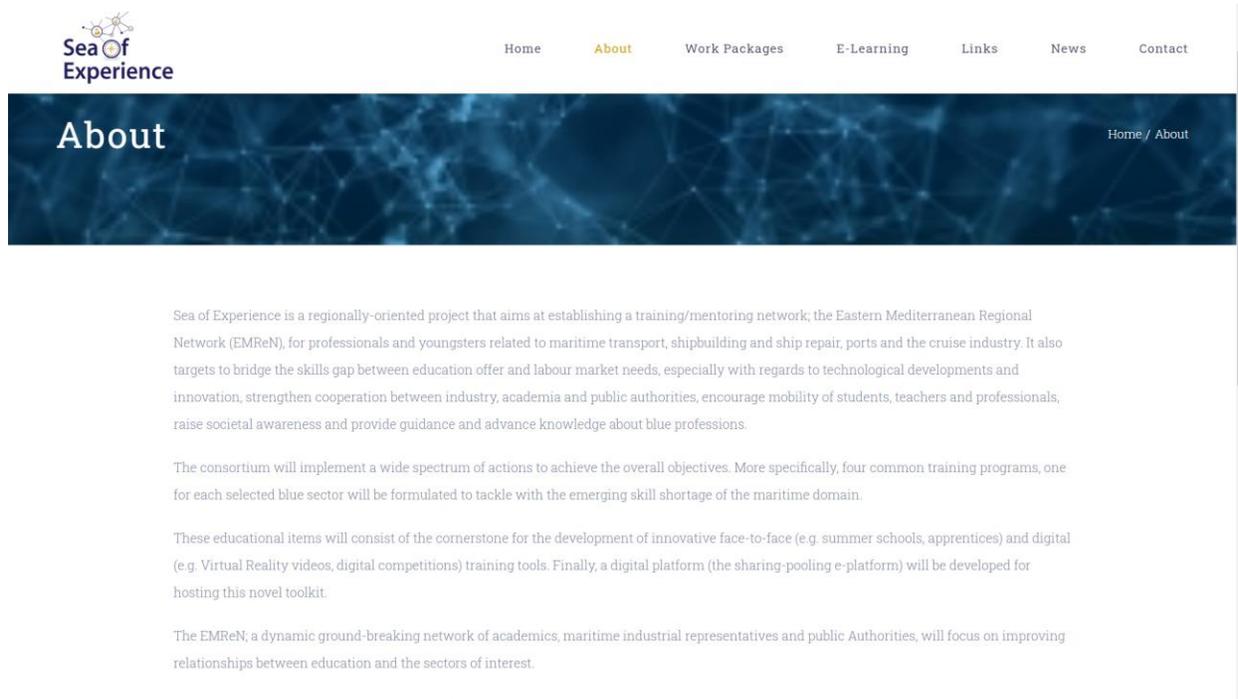


Figure 4 Samples of the other pages of the website

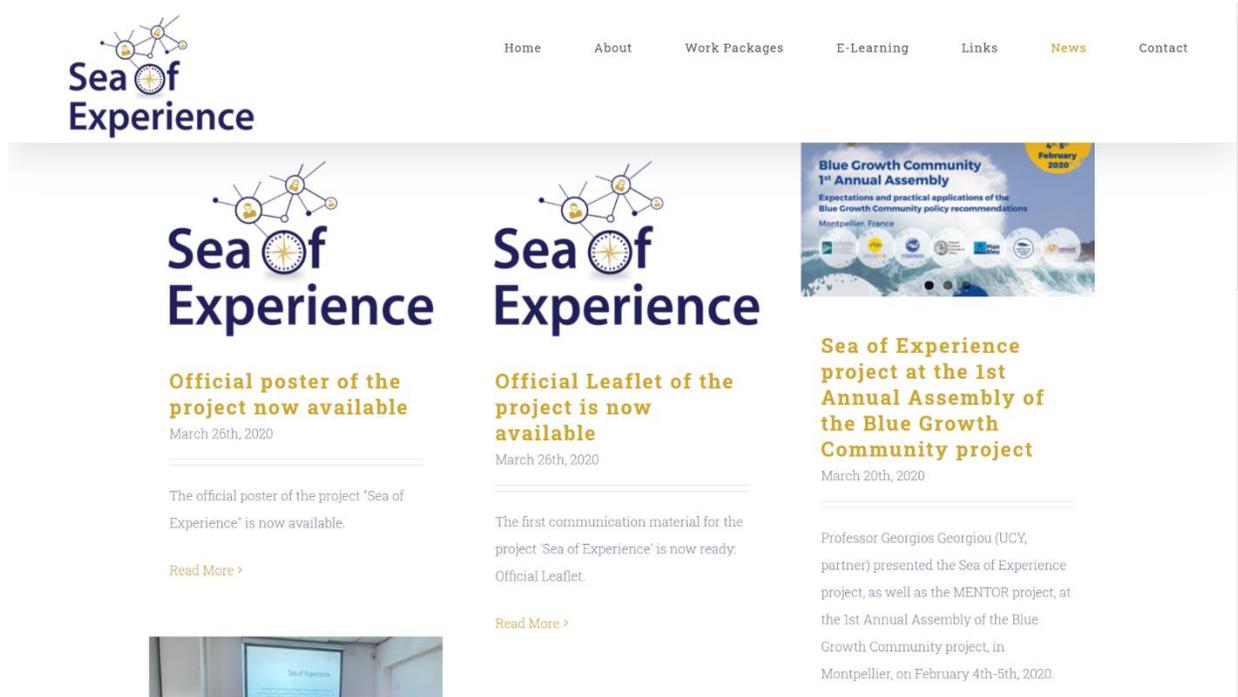


Figure 5 Samples of the other pages of the website

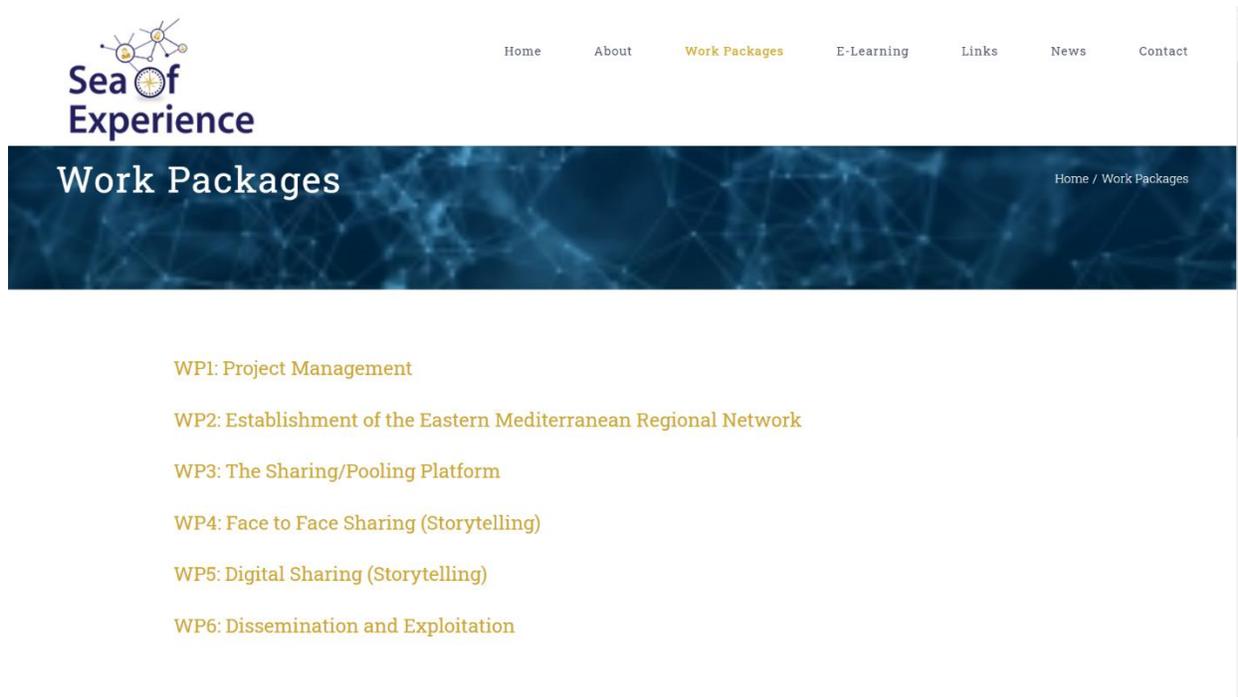


Figure 6 Samples of the other pages of the website

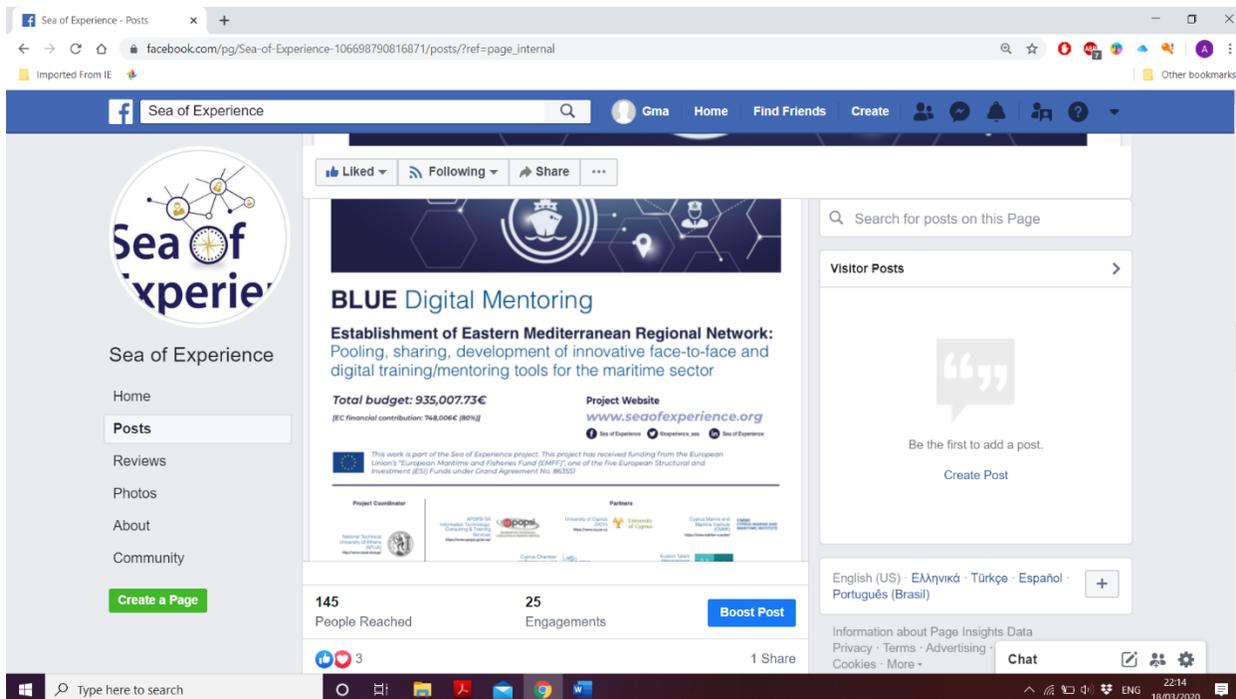


Figure 7 Facebook account screenshot

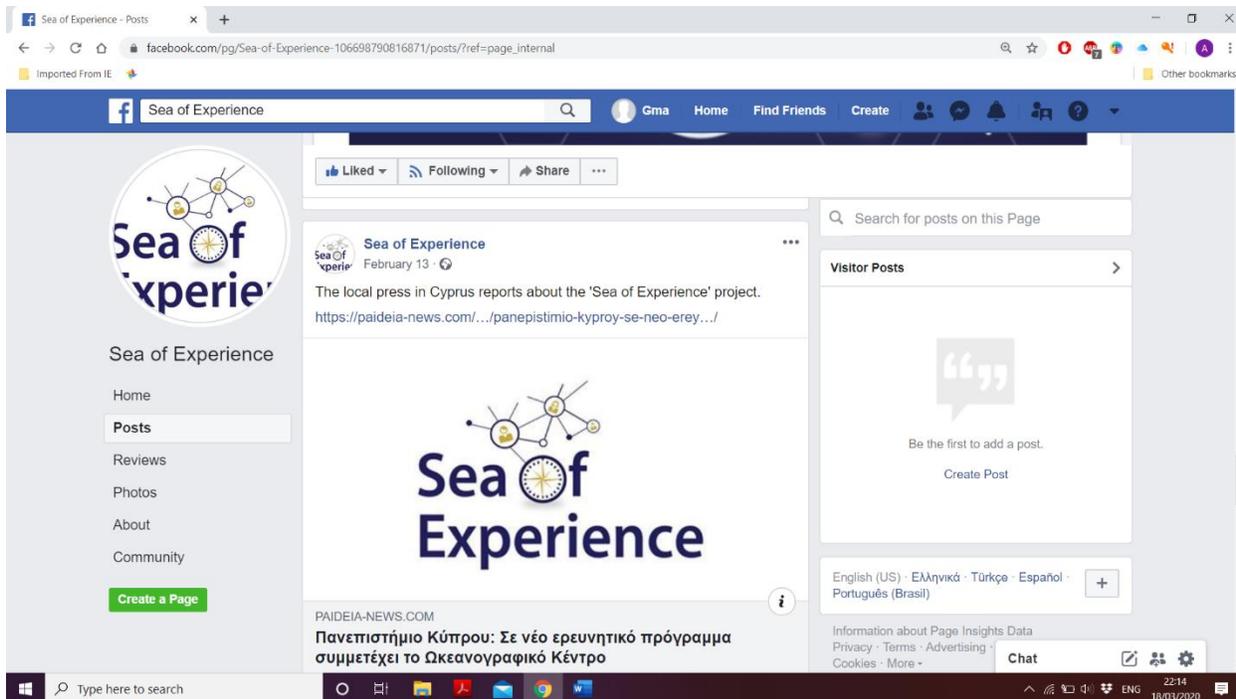


Figure 8 Facebook account screenshot



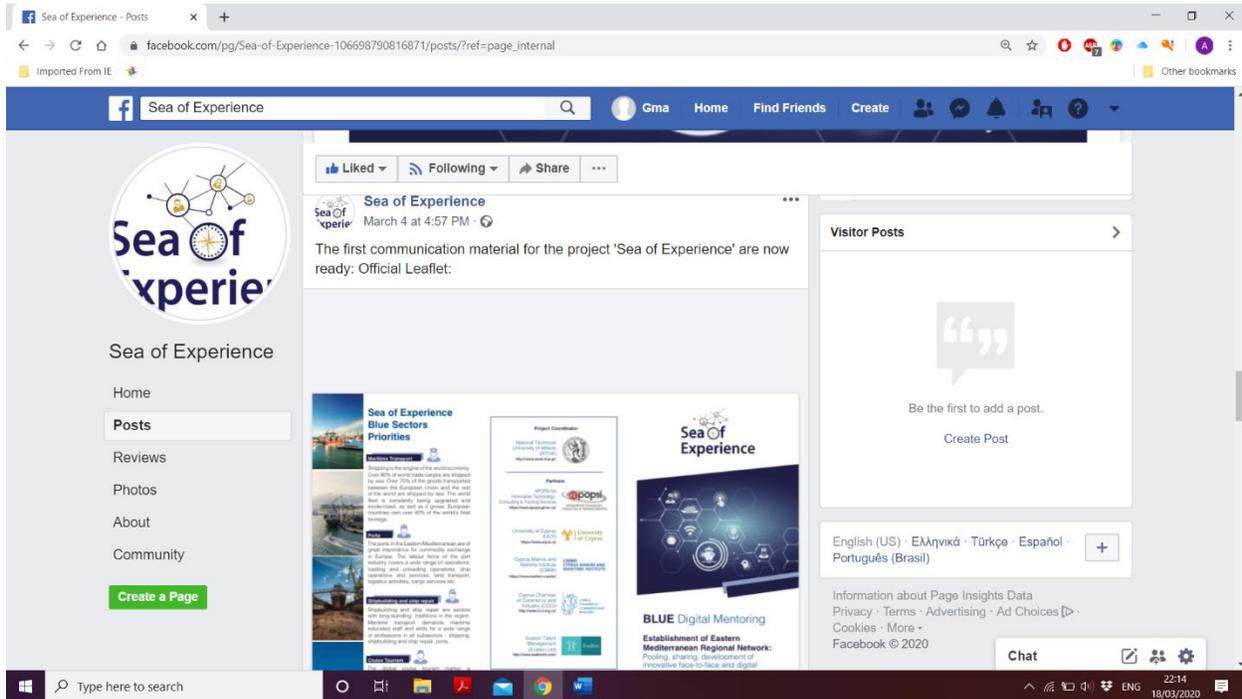


Figure 9 Facebook account screenshot

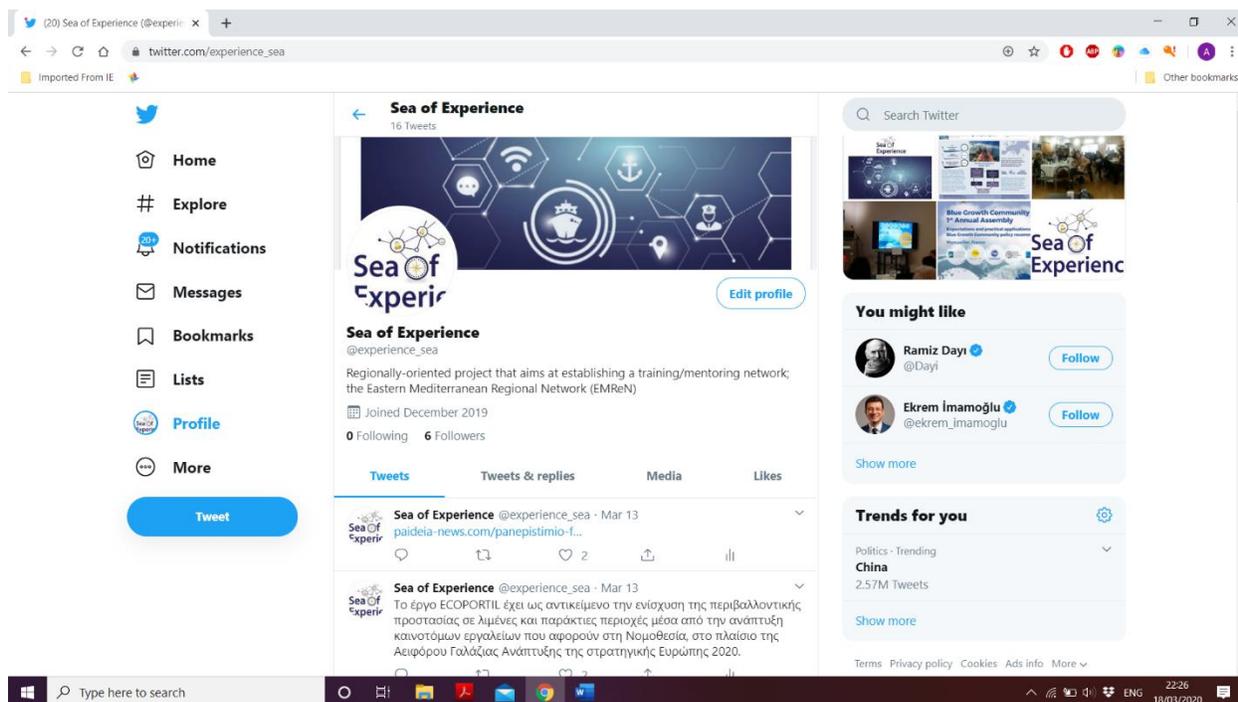


Figure 10 Twitter account screenshot

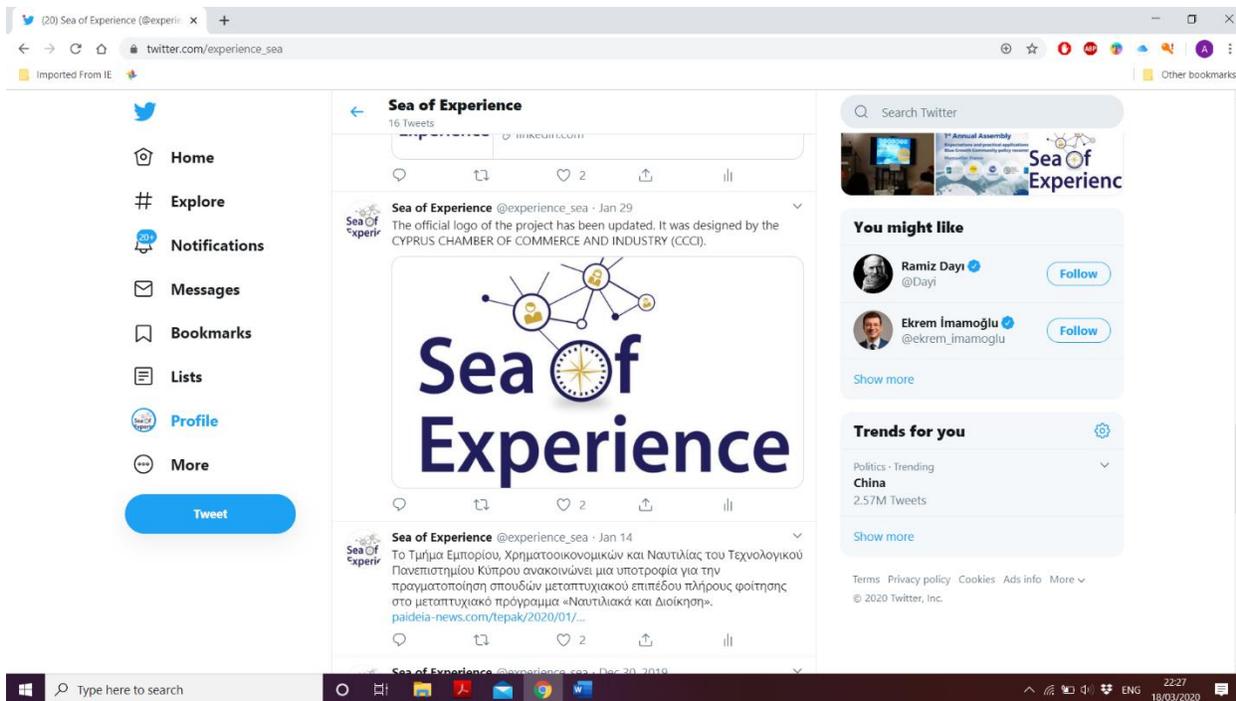


Figure 11 Twitter account screenshot

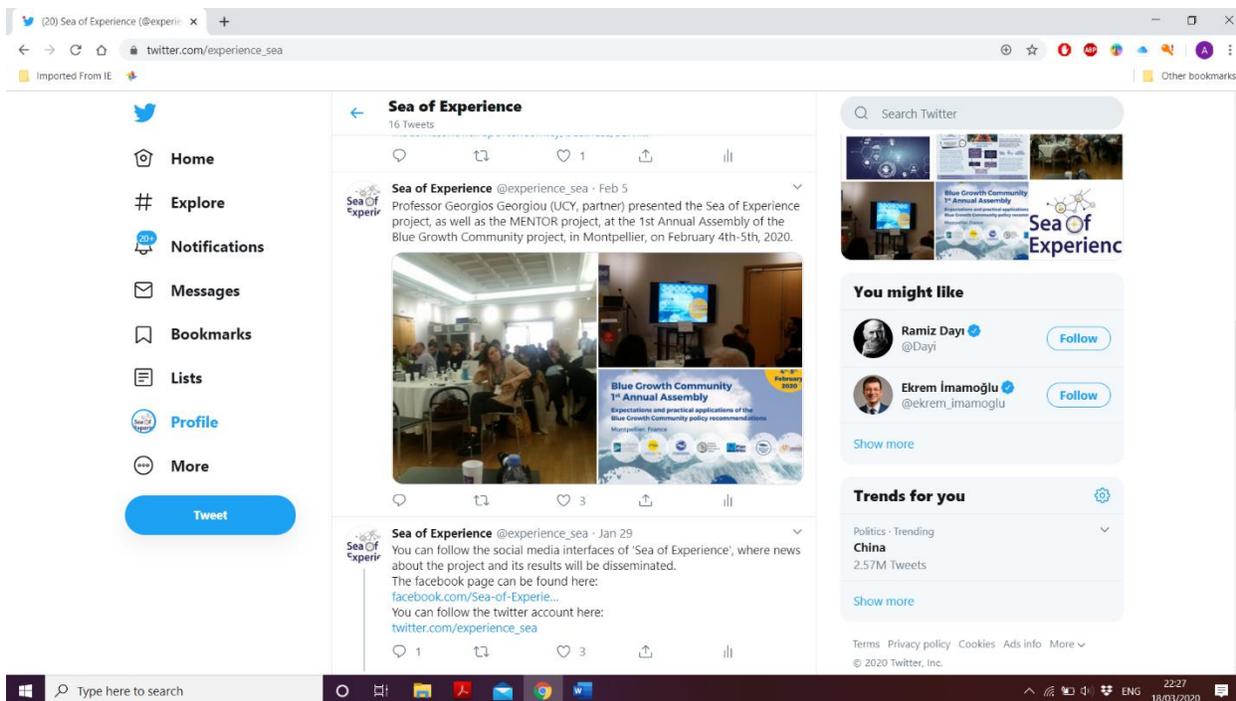


Figure 12 Twitter account screenshot

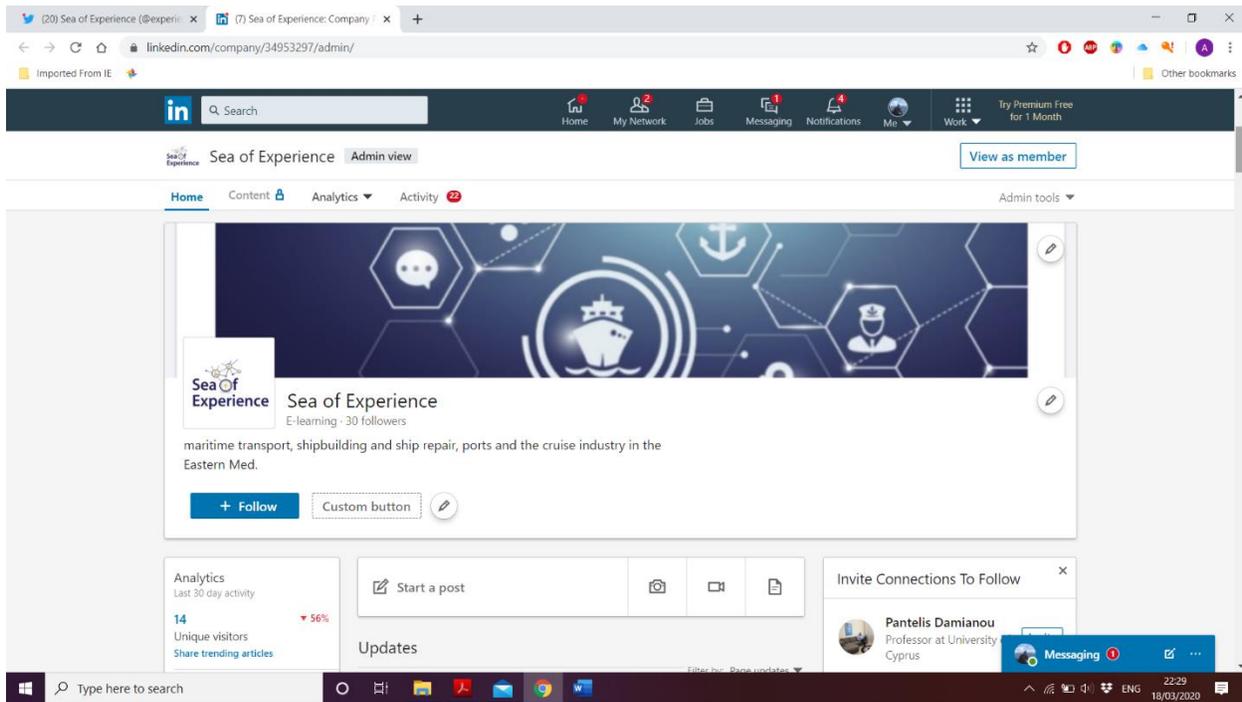


Figure 13 LinkedIn account screenshot

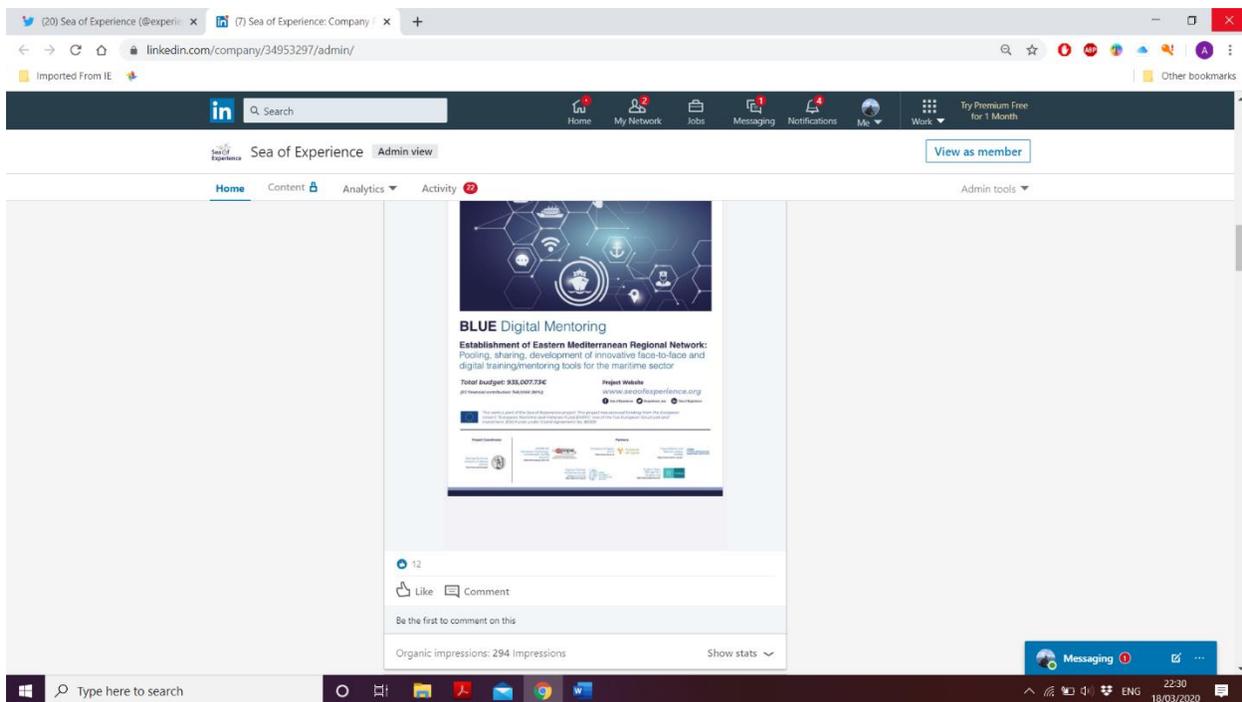


Figure 14 LinkedIn account screenshot



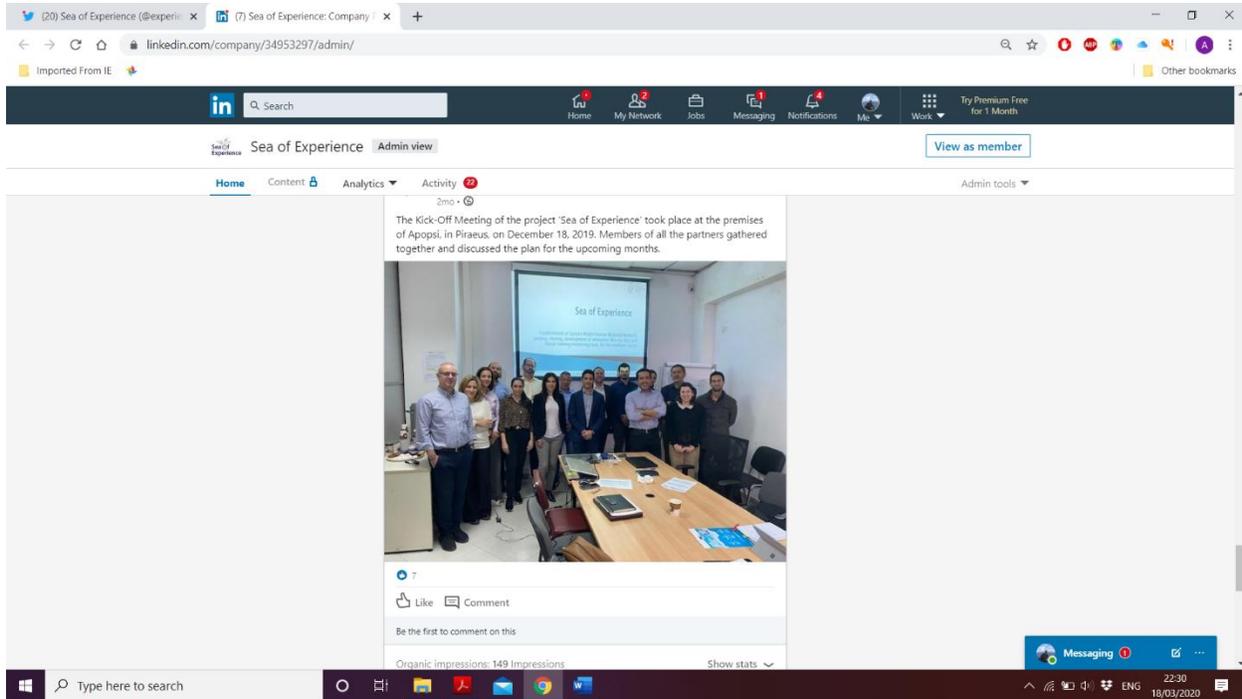


Figure 15 LinkedIn account screenshot
